ST. CLAIR COUNTY COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CHILDREN'S CENTER PARKING LOT EXPANSION PROJECT BMJ Project No. 2009.14

St. Clair County Community Mental Health will receive sealed bids until 10:00 am local time, on Thursday, July 29, 2021 at the St. Clair County Community Mental Health Main Building 3111 Electric Avenue, Port Huron, Michigan 48060, at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The lump sum base bid and allowances will be for asphalt paving, including aggregate base, concrete sidewalk, storm sewer, landscaping and lawn restoration. The approximate quantities for the major items of work involved in this project are as follows:

- Asphalt Paving – 1,700 tons
- Aggregate Base – 7,000 square yards
- Geotextile Stabilization – 7,000 square yards
- Pavement Removal – 3,250 square yards
- Concrete Curb and Gutter – 1,200 feet
- Concrete Sidewalk – 2,000 square feet
- 12-inch Storm Sewer – 140 feet
- 6-inch and 8-inch Storm Sewer – 160 feet
- 6-inch Underdrain – 150 feet
- Lawn Restoration – 4,500 square yards

As required by Federal Law, the following requirements apply to this project: Equal Employment Opportunity, Davis-Bacon Act (Prevailing Wage), Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act, Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, Rights to Inventions Made Under a Contract Agreement, Clean Air Act and Federal Water Pollution Control Act, Byrd Anti-Lobbying Amendment, and Procurement of Recovered Materials.

Bids shall be on an overall project lump sum basis. Bids shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided by the Engineer.

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Bid security in the form of a Certified Check or a Bid Bond, executed by the bidder and a surety company, for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid, payable to St. Clair County Community Mental Health, shall be submitted with each bid.

St. Clair County Community Mental Health reserves the right to accept any Bid, to reject any Bid, and to waive irregularities in Bids. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond, Payment Bond, Maintenance Bond and Insurance Certificates.

Bids may not be withdrawn for sixty (60) calendar days after receipt.
