Agency Directive re: Dress Code

- Until further notice, the Agency Dress Code, as defined in policy #06-001-0150, shall be more relaxed due to COVID-19 and the need to be flexible, with many services provided alternatively, including within the community.
- Employees may select clothing appropriate for the weather, including shorts of an appropriate length, capris, skorts, jeans, etc.
- Employees must use good judgment and present a well-groomed appearance and dress in a manner promoting a positive image for the agency.
- Employee clothing choices should be suitable for the work tasks for the day, e.g., court.
- Employees are encouraged to wear clothing that is easy to wash and should wash/sanitize clothing frequently for health and safety purposes.
- Should clothing be deemed inappropriate, employees may be asked to return home on their own time to change.
